



## APS ENVIRONMENTAL Environmental Policy

APS Environmental as a company welcomes and accepts its civic responsibility in environmental matters with regard to Customer relationships and the services they require. The company recognises the process of continual changes and advancements in environmental matters and their policy is to effect a continuing review of industry standards both in the UK and internationally. The company will seek to implement improvements and develop an understanding of Environmental requirements in order to achieve the highest industry standards.

The points listed below form the basis of the Company's Environmental Policy:-

- 1) All the company's operations will conform to or exceed all appropriate Waste Management Legislation and other Regulatory standards.
- 2) The company is striving to reduce its carbon footprint and operate within a paperless environment.
- 3) The company will seek to make their Customers fully aware of their own environmental and legislative responsibilities with regard to Waste Disposal and Waste Management and related activities.
- 4) The company will ensure that all equipment is cleaned, maintained and always operated within legal limits, taking full advantage of all pollution and emission reduction improvements.
- 5) The company operates a continuing Staff training programme to ensure that there are no unnecessary or inappropriate risks while handling waste materials or the recycled products.
- 6) The company will take appropriate measures to ensure that the collection, transport, storage, recycling, reclamation and disposal facilities used by the company do not become hazardous to the general public or the environment.

- 7) The company will ensure that all transportation and disposal of waste is covered by a written agreement, specific quotation, letter or order as well as Duty of Care (section 34) and the Environmental Protection Act (1990) documentation. The company will make every effort to ensure the compliance of third parties within the legislative requirements.
- 8) The company co-operates with and assists officers of the Waste Regulatory Authorities in the exercise of their duties.
- 9) The company will only use its recycling facilities at times when the level of operational control and environmental compliance is deemed of a suitable level.
- 10) The company has a policy of compliance with the Codes of Practice and Guidance published by NAWDC. The company supports the policies of NAWDC and avoids acts that may bring the company, industry or NAWCD in disrepute. All staff are aware of this policy and comply accordingly.
- 11) The company constantly updates its knowledge and ability to recycle waste materials and minimise energy wastage.
- 12) The company will continue to support and sustain its research into environmental projects.
